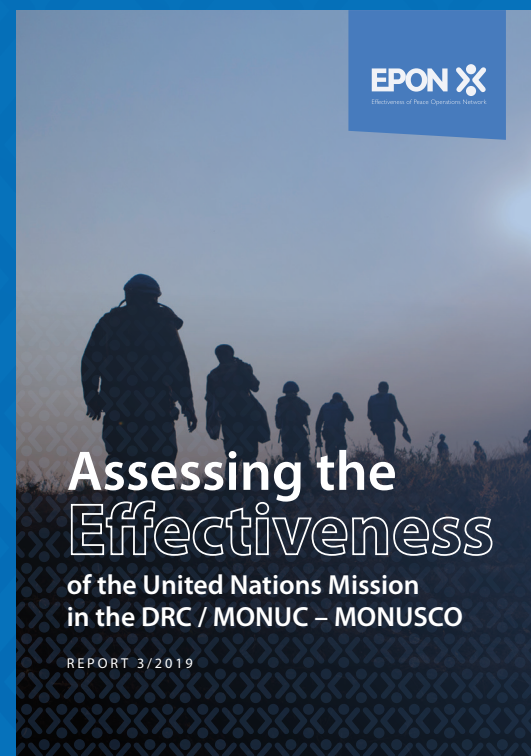
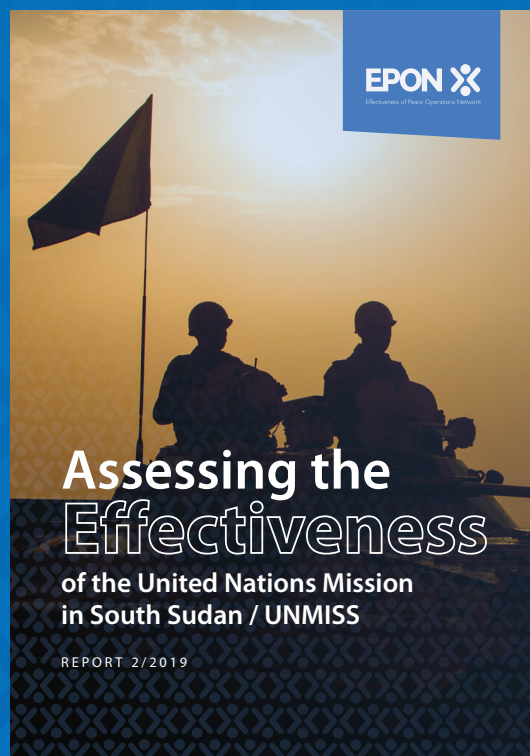
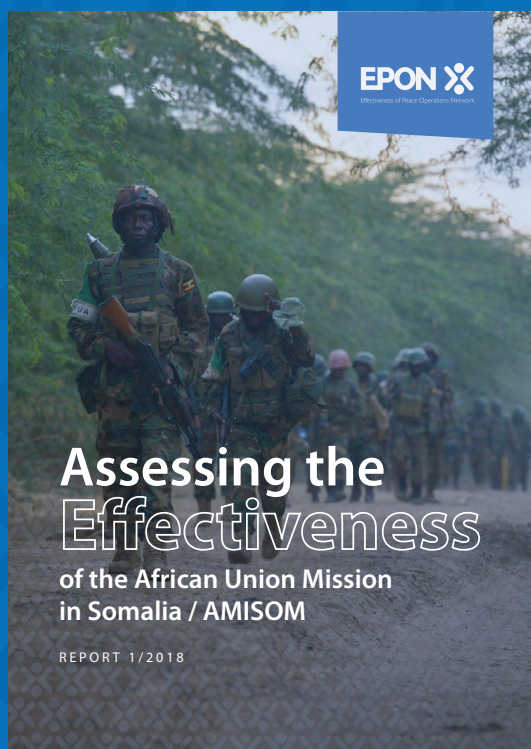




Currently there are over 40 think tanks, academic institutions, training centres and other institutions with specific expertise on peace operations from all over the world in the EPON research network.

The first four pilot case studies were undertaken in 2018, in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (MONUSCO), Mali (MINUSMA), Somalia (AMISOM) and South Sudan (UNMISS). In 2019 the project will continue with studies in Darfur (UNAMID), the Central African Republic (MINUSCA), Ukraine (EU & OSCE Mission) and Columbia (UN Mission).
